### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The logistical upgrade/improvement of TPRA is a project of significant relevance for Tirana Municipality. This is due to the increasing needs and expectations in a greater territory and more responsibilities and competences concerning TPRA. Modern logistic services and solutions, technological equipment and tools need to be available on a continuous basis, which is not the case at the present moment. TPRA today, is highly dependent on other directorates or private companies for logistical support which causes nearly 40% loss of the annual commitment. This project represents a key capital investment able to bring significant economic, social and environment benefits (fuel cost reduction, efficiency of processes/timesaving, lower environment and acoustic pollution, better facilities for the users, higher safety etc.)

### OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Improved and efficient management and maintenance of the current and future parks through the modernization and mechanization of the work processes and technological equipment.

### PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION MODALITY

This project will be implemented with both donors' financial assistance and municipality's funds, through standard public procurement procedures. TPRA will firstly draft the technical specifications needed for the procurement procedures. It will further organize and monitor training of its staff prior to the use of equipment and vehicles. The list of technologic vehicles, tools, equipment, and all other necessary means, will be defined in detail.
