PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The crossing of roads by pedestrians in some very dense intersection has become a serious problem for the citizens of Tirana and public authorities. The problem is especially difficult for children, the elderly and people with disabilities. Until now the situation has been solved by means of traffic lights which in turn create traffic congestions and increase of pollution in these areas.

The project aims to develop several pedestrian bridges which give access to disabled people through long ramps, which will facilitate the crossing of several crossroads that have become hotspots of problems citizens and accidents.

These include:

- Elbasani Street, at the crossroad of the Student Campuses;
- Lapraka
- by the Botanic Park and Tirana Zoo park
- the existing pedestrian bridge over the River Lana at the Gjin Bue Shpata street

OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Address the complaints of citizens and facilitate mobility by building several pedestrian bridges in the densely populated areas and hotspots where street crossing continues to be problematic.

PRELIMINARY IMPACT

The anticipated impact will be the easing of traffic congestions thus facilitating mobility, reducing pollution and traffic jams caused by the frequent pedestrian crossing. The bridges will also improve road security for drivers and pedestrians.
